- Description of the TRANSBASE

Sharing strategic functions and harmonising ports processes through a common Port Community System (PCS), connecting ports of Greece (Piraeus, Patras and Igoumenitsa) with Adriatic ports

- Time frame of the TRANSBASE: From 2021 to 2024 (3 years project)
- Maturity level of the TRANSBASE

The maturity level of the project depends on current information systems that Port Authorities use. In any case, most of the ports that are suggested to participate in this project have implemented already studies for the development of a PCS or are using already a PCS.
